




TO HYDRATE AND MAINTAIN BABIES' SKIN BARRIER



NEONATES AND INFANTS ARE SUSCEPTIBLE TO SKIN BARRIER DISRUPTION¹

- -30% thinner stratum corneum (SC)¹
- High trans-epidermal water loss (TEWL)¹
- More fragile and prone to infections¹
- Elevated pH¹
- More susceptible to thermal damage¹


